Ad Hoc Committee Report – Debit Card for RCMs

The Ad Hoc met on 6/13/18 at 7:00 PM. The initial discussion was regarding the necessity of a debit card / separate account for the Bay Area RCM team to utilize for hotel accommodations for Regional Service Committee (RSC) weekends. The thought was to have the RCM book the hotel accommodations, and then communicate the hotel cost (plus any incidental holds) to the Bay Area Treasurer who would then transfer the appropriate amount from the BASCNA bank account to the Bay Area RCM account. After the RSC weekend charges were deducted by the hotel, any remaining money in the Bay Area RCM account would then be transferred back into the BASCNA account.

As an RCM I have reviewed the suggested process and determined the following:

Every time there were new elections (RCM, Treasurer, Area Chair) the cards would have to be re-issued with the new RCM name (involving trips to the bank and possible charges for new cards).

Many hotels require a significant amount of money to be “held” when using a debit card instead of a credit card which would be difficult to calculate and require funds to be moved back and forth between accounts.

I would like to suggest the following:

In keeping with the current Bay Area policy which states in the responsibilities section of the RCM 1 “Responsible for ensuring that the hotel rooms for the RCMs and subcommittee chairs are reserved for the next Regional meeting, working in conjunction with the ASC Treasurer”, the RCM 1 will reserve the required room(s) in the RSC room block for RSC weekend. At the Area Service Committee (ASC) meeting prior to RSC weekend the RCM 1 will fill out a check request(s) for the cost of the room(s) and include a copy of the reservation confirmation for transparency. Additionally, at the ASC after RSC weekend the RCM 1 will provide a copy of the room receipt to the Bay Area Treasurer.

I feel that this suggestion is in alignment with our current policy, and is in the best interest of the Bay Area.
