Public Relations

At this month's subcommittee meeting we discussed participation at the "Fed up" event which will be August 31st. This event is driven towards bringing awareness of the opioid epidemic in our community. In attendance will be many professionals in the field of addiction. We ran into some issues with our sales rep from Metropolitan Benches. There were damaged benches we had reported for several months that were not repaired. However, after contacting the owner directly he
