
BASCNA Inventory Survey 2017

It is suggested that you read these sections with your homegroup prior to filling out this survey. The spirit of this survey is embodied in the publication *A Guide to Local Services*, published by NAWS, Inc.

The intent of an Area inventory is to discover how well the area performs its primary purpose and to provide support for the meetings within that area. This is absolutely not the place to take another members inventory, however, there may be some inventory input that might be necessary for a specific position. Keeping spiritual principles in mind, always, is imperative.

The area inventory considers three general topics:

- 1. How well has the area committee done this year at serving the groups, and how can it better serve them in the coming year?
- 2. How well has the area committee served the larger community, and how can the committee better serve the community-at-large?
- 3. How well has the area committee done at supporting NA's regional and world services? How can the area provide better support for these services?



Serving the Groups

- 2. If the ASC and/or subcommittees were to organize more workshops would your group members be willing to participate?
- 3. What don't you understand about Area? (In what ways could the area help you better understand its role/purpose?)
- 4. Do your groups know all that the basket is for? Does your area handle Narcotics Anonymous funds properly? Do you keep the fund flow moving?
- 5. Does the Area respond to the needs of local groups? If not, what can we do better?
- 6. How positively is a sense of unity shown within local groups?
