## *Ad Hoc*

Ad Hoc Subcommittee “*To figure out what the hell we’re doing with policy.*”

The Ad Hoc subcommittee met on Saturday 3/28/2026 at 1:00pm at the Terra Nova clubhouse (not affiliated). There were 9 members in attendance: Michael V., Judi M., Jeannie K., Mike M., Janet D., Chris B., Angelo B., Brook L., and Drew F.

The Ad Hoc discussed the various issues with the way the Police Subcommittee was currently running, clarified that it is still a subcommittee, but also concluded that it is a hybrid, since both the Policy Chair and the Policy Vice Chair are elected by the ASC body as a whole during admin elections, and that the Vice Chair is not elected by the subcommittee.

It was discussed that since the Policy Subcommittee is indeed still a subcommittee, that Policy decisions should still be made by the Policy Subcommittee members (all GSRs and Subcommittee Chairpersons), and not just left to the Policy Chair and Policy Vice Chair to decide. We discussed the need for clarity going forward, and the ad hoc is making the following recommendations:

1) That the policy be reverted to re-insert all of the language making it clear that Policy is a subcommittee and not just an admin position (see motion #2026.02.08.06).

2) That a line item be inserted into the ASC Agenda (page 2 of policy), before “12) Old Business”, to the effect of:

12) If it is determined that the Policy Subcommittee needs to meet, then it is convened and the ASC Chair turns the meeting over to the Policy Chair until the business of Policy is concluded. Only 1 motion will be considered on the floor at a time.

Note: item #2 will require a motion be submitted, and the subsequent line items renumbered.

3) Policy needs to redo their guidelines to reflect the new flow.

The Ad Hoc also discussed the need for Policy members to be able to see the actual motions being discussed as they are attempting to determine whether or not they violate any Traditions, Concepts, or conflict with current policy. Options discussed were gaining the use of the projector already in the meeting room, or uploading a picture of the policy to an area of the BASCNA website where members could view the motions on their phones.
