Disruptive and Predatory Behavior. Several members expressed concerns regarding disruptive and predatory behavior toward newcomers. One group requested that ASC acknowledge safety as a public issue and encourage groups to discuss steps to protect the newcomer and anyone seeking recovery. Members discussed predatory behavior and possible solutions to ensure more safety for recovering addicts. The following solutions were discussed:

- Attend meetings where more newcomers are present.
- Create group policies on recognizing and addressing predatory behavior at the home group level (each group is autonomous).
- Reference local resources on the topic and information coming back from Region. Select the following links to view local resources: [Disruptive and Predatory Behavior](#), [Predatory Behavior](#).
- When necessary, approach facility where home group meets regarding inappropriate behavior - the facility itself can ban individuals from the premises.
- Create a Common Welfare Ad Hoc.

Serenity in Addiction asked for guidance on holding a Labor Day event in partnership with the meeting's facility and home groups from other fellowships.
