Ernest E – Bay Area Report

I attended RSC the weekend of September 19th-21st. I participated in the Welcome Meeting which takes place Friday night from 9pm-11pm, this is an open discussion meeting, my experience was this meeting offered a lot of recovery and solutions for those that have been in NA for long periods of time.

Saturday's Fellowship Development and here they spoke on many topics impacting the Florida Region which consist of 20 Areas including a couple island nations. Some of the topics discussed were:

1. Consensus Based Decision Making vs Robert's Rules of Order for budgetary items, this discussion consisted of switching from Robert's Rules simple majority 50% + 1 to Consensus Bases which 80%. No firm conclusion came from this and discussion is ongoing.
2. Facing the challenge of maintaining hybrid service, meaning both in person and virtual, this topic is also still in discussion.
3. Enhancing or combining RSC PR and H&I, currently H&I communication with facilities is at a low level and the two coordinators will collaborate to assist H&I in carrying the message.
4. There were several other topics in discussion, however these stood out for me and Bay Area RCM will be reporting on the remainder.

Sunday RSC Business:

Here is when all of the business for RSC weekend had taken place and all the votes on proposals and elections have taken place. I find that RSC is involved in a lot to carry NA's message. Also, we have the CAR (Conference Agenda Report) coming up with all World motions to be voted on. All in all RSC is always education and informative with what is going on around Narcotics Anonymous.
