Web Admin

Several technical issues brought to our attention have been resolved:

- The PDF meeting list link is functioning properly.
- Mobile menu scrolling has been restored.

I'd also like to address the motion to dissolve the ASC Zoom platform.

According to the BASCNA Policy (May 2024),

WEB ADMIN & ALTERNATE WEB ADMIN The purposes of these positions are to maintain the BASCNA Web page. It is the responsibility of the Web Admin & Alt. Web Admin to update the page on a monthly basis after every ASC; update individual Subcommittee guidelines as they are provided; and to post (BASCNA POLICY) on the website. This

policy will be the same as the official Policy that is passed out to each GSR, Subcommittee Chairs, RCM's, and members of the Administrative Committee biannually. On the task of maintaining BASCNA Administrative positions and subcommittee Chairpersons on World Service Office database, the Web Admin will be the "Single Point of Accountability" to the Bay Area ASC. The Bay Area Web Admin, is to post the minutes from ASC on the web site (www.bascna.org). These minutes will be the same as the official minutes that are emailed out to each GSR, Subcommittee chairs, RCM's and members of the Administrative Committee.

During the pandemic, Zoom was a vital tool that allowed our fellowship to continue meeting and serving. While virtual NA meetings remain impactful, Zoom attendance for Bay Area ASC has significantly declined—averaging only 1–2 GSRs logging in each month for at least the past 12 months. As both Alt Web Admin and now Web Admin, I've found that managing the Zoom platform during ASC prevents me from fulfilling my core responsibilities outlined in policy. Supporting in-person attendees and mentoring the Alt Web Admin becomes nearly impossible while facilitating Zoom. Separately, chairing a Zoom and being Web Admin are very manageable roles, however when you combine them it is very difficult to manage both tasks.

Additionally, the equipment originally purchased to support Zoom is deteriorating. As of August ASC, the external webcam is non-functional, and the laptop's built-in camera has long been inoperable—meaning video is no longer available.

Of course, Admin is here to serve the home groups of our area based on their groups' conscience. If the groups wish to continue using Zoom for ASC, it is my opinion that a new role should be created within the Admin Body to manage this platform, as it does not currently fall under any existing ASC position's responsibilities outlined in BASCNA Policy.
