- Notes from Regional Area Support Meeting:
 - Some Areas within the Florida Region restructuring their ASC to mirror Region by eliminating the need to independent subcommittees and installing a Fellowship Development position which all subcommittees are funneled through. Some Areas cite this makes their ASC efficient and subcommittees more productive.
 - Bay Area RCM asked for experience, strength and hope regarding GSRs being divided over a decision to move ASC to another location. Feedback included applying spiritual principles into the decision making; ask the new facility to post financials if there is a concern regarding stability;
 - The Florida Regional Service Symposium is conducted as part of the Southeast Zonal Forum which consist of the following states: Carolina Region, North Carolina Region, Georgia Region, Alabama/Northwest Florida Region, South Florida Region and Florida Region. A discussion was held on changing the Florida Service Symposium to a Zonal Symposium meaning it can be hosted by any Region within the Southeast Zonal Forum. Existing Workgroups

- Regional Helpline: Conclusion of workgroup. After 6 months of working to have a regional helpline with statewide capabilities that would customizable extensions that will ring to calling queues or forwarding numbers when they select a specific area's extension and forward call appropriately to that area's caller of choice. This would also have the capability to have areas opt in and eliminate their area's helpline and allow the regional helpline committee to handle the calls for them. The Process: If an area chooses to opt in this is what would happen... The caller calls then select Pasco option. If Pasco chose to opt in they wouldn't have their own volunteers so it would ring to a live regional volunteer addict that would answer and guide them in their search of a meeting or any other answers they would have.

1. Caller calls helpline.

2. They select zip code, city, county or area code.

3. It forwards to the areas helpline or to a regional helpline volunteer if area chose to opt in.

Areas that opt in would be required to have a Helpline Coordinator for that area.

The company is Grasshopper.

Cost: \$200 per month / \$2400 per year that includes 10k minutes, unlimited extensions, they do all the greetings and voice set up in many different languages.
