Treasurer's Report

July Bank statement showed opening balance of \$5,584.83, and a closing balance of 4,737.59. Both the bank statement and the check book balanced to the penny. August inflows were \$1618.58 from group donations, and \$1561.75 from sale of literature. Check #1385, made out to the IRS for \$35 was voided, because it was reissued. August expenses totaled \$5,550.79, details of which are in the Treasurer report attached. This caused a negative monthly cash flow of \$2335.46, which was covered by funds in our Prudent Reserve.
