### *Policy*

Policy Report – February Business – March ASC

Policy revisions have been made to reflect all motions passed that required a policy change through March 2026. I have emailed a copy of the updated policy to the Web Admin to be posted on the BASCNA website.

I found one motion that was passed during April ASC 2024 that has not sufficiently been reflected in the policy. The motion was passed “**To have Policy absorbed by ASC (combined).**” (2024.2.11.4) The definition of absorb in this context is to take control of (a smaller or less powerful entity) and make it part of a larger entity. The definition of combine in this context is to unite, merge, to form a single entity.

I reached out to the motion maker because there seems to be some confusion or consensus amongst some members of area service about whether Policy is still a subcommittee or not. According to the motion that was passed & the motion makers intent, **(to dissolve the Policy subcommittee, there would still be a Chair & Vice Chair - existing strictly as members of admin, similar to the Secretary & Alternate Secretary. Policy would not exist as a separate committee. All discussions involving the policy would be held with GSR’s in attendance)**

The changes that were made to the policy after this motion passed were not sufficient to support or reflect the passing of this motion. The only change I found that was made was the removal of the word subcommittee from wherever it existed after the word policy. This supports the intent of the motion, but other changes needed to be made to clearly capture the intent of the motion. I also found that the policy as it reads currently contradicts itself implies in some areas that Policy is a Subcommittee, but also in other areas implies that it is not a subcommittee. I have compiled a list of policy discrepancies and/or suggestions to either remove, relocate, add or revise certain items.

## Current Policy

Table of Contents shows Policy under Subcommittee section.

Page 1 – Definitions – Shows Policy under Subcommittees & calls it a “body”.

Page 3 – Definition of an ASC –Last Sentence “All GSRs and Subcommittee Chairpersons are members of policy.” Is redundant – They are automatically members because Policy is combined with ASC, Last paragraph does not include Policy Chair or Policy Vice Chair in the third sentence in parenthesis with the rest of the officers – which implies Subcommittee Chair and Vice Chair.

Page 7 – Motion Guidelines – Item 3 does not include Policy Chair & Vice Chair with the Admin officers.

Page 9 – Terms of Office – Item 1 includes Policy Chair & Vice Chair along with the other Admin officers. Item 2 – is for all Subcommittee Chairs – This implies that Policy is not a subcommittee.

Item 5.b.i – Includes Policy Vice Chair – as being automatically nominated to fill Policy Chair like any other Admin member – not as being elected by its own subcommittee. The point being that this implies Policy is part of Admin as separate from Subcommittees. Note (Policy Chair is missing from the second part of this)

Pages 10, 11, 12, & 13 – Under Responsibilities of Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, Secretary, Treasurer, Lit Distributor & RCM there is an item that states “Shall serve as a standing member of policy”. This is redundant. Policy is combined with ASC – they are all members of the ASC – they are automatically members of Policy.

## Page 15 - ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE -

The last sentence stating that all GSRs and Subcommittee Chairpersons are member of Policy is redundant – they are automatically members as Policy is combined with ASC,

Last paragraph before that – the Policy Chair is included in the first part of the paragraph along with other admin positions & is separated from Subcommittee Chairpersons.

Page 16 – Under Responsibilities of Subcommittee Chairperson –

Item 8 - All Sub Chairs are members of Policy. Redundant - This is automatic as Policy is combined with ASC.

Page 17 – Policy – This section is under Subcommittees section – Not a subcommittee – should be moved.

Page 21 - RULES OF ORDER

Item 4.c - Includes Policy and Alt Policy with all other admin members.

(Note: it does not say Chair & Vice Chair.

Item 4.d - is for all Subcommittee Chairpersons & Vice Chairpersons

I made a copy of the current policy & I made all the changes that I deemed necessary to clearly distinguish Policy as strictly being part of the administrative body – to not be implied as a Subcommittee.

I will have this available for the Ad-hoc and at the next ASC meeting.

I unfortunately was an hour late for Area this month –the time change got me good. I had intended to bring all of this to the Admin meeting prior to Area Service, but I instead had to bring it up during a motion that I deemed to be out of order, which resulted in that motion being tabled & a decision was made at that time also to create an Ad-hoc (Temporary Committee) to figure out what we are doing with Policy.
